1. **Developing Renewable Energy:** Developing Renewable Energy Projects for Community Benefit
2. **Strengthening Communities:** Supporting Community Groups to Build Capacity and Achieve Social and Environmental Benefits (target areas include: children, young adult, older and disabled communities)
3. **Energy and Fuel Efficiency:** Supporting individuals/Groups in modernising outdated fuel systems and energy savings
